Treasurer's report:

- *First Time Filers SERC report*- We had two first time filers. Wayne Health Care and the Airport filed for the first time.

- Have been focused primarily on the exercise. Now that exercise is over I will be resuming data entry.

Citizen Corps

- CERT – Nothing significant to report. Plan to research building program further and shoot for a basic CERT class in the fall.
- MRC – Used MRC for April drive through clinic.

- Randy Earl, discussed putting together a Family Reception Center workshop. It is about an hour and a half workshop. It will discuss who in the county will come forward in the event of a mass casualty incident.
- Pam Garland, we have been very busy. We have seen a 35% increase in wheelchairs. Dealing with increased gas prices. We are doing the fair shuttle again this year. We are hiring. Have been dealing with bedbugs.
- Eric Cook, today is the quarterly triage for the regions ems units. It starts at 8am and goes on for 24 hours. All patients that are transport by EMS will get a triage tag. Looking at doing a table top active shooter exercise in the fall. Will reach out with more info.
- Tom Hans, tire recycling is September 26th and Household Hazardous Waste is October 6th. Everything else is running smooth.
- Terry Holman, Flu season is over. The swine flu is a summer issue. We will be keeping an eye on the exhibits.
- Mike Rhodes, officially had a new dog warden and assistant dog warden start yesterday. We are getting things back to normal out there. Other than that, we are working on the budget.
