- <u>Jeff Yantis</u> The Amateur Radio group repeater has had some issue arise so they may need access to the equipment in the Sheriff's Office.

- <u>Sam Reed –</u> The Region 3 Strike Team responded to Auglaize County to assist with a structure collapse. The team includes members from the Greenville Fire Dept. and the assistance was spoken very highly of by the St. Mary's Fire Chief.
